CAWS Proposals Review Procedure

- March 1: Deadline to submit proposals.
 - Applicants will be requested to provide names of potential reviewers external to Purdue University with whom no conflict of interest exists with the PI and Co--PIs.
- March 15-April 1: Review panel assembly
 - Reviewers will be invited to serve as a virtual panel.
 - Each proposal will be assigned two reviewers.
- April 1-May 1: Review of submissions and compilation of scores
- May 1-May 30: Virtual panel discussion (if needed)
- June 1: Successful proposals will be funded based on scores and discussion between reviewers. Awardees will receive notification; all applicants receive scores and reviewer feedback.
- Proposal evaluation criteria: (see http://vet.purdue.edu/CAWS/ for the detailed scoring sheet)
 - Aims and significance
 - o Approach
 - o Innovation/creativity
 - o Metrics and measurement of impact
 - o Interdisciplinary team approach
 - Leverage of other funding sources/potential to attract other funds
 - Capacity building with collaborators external to Purdue University
 - Elements of training/engaging young professionals in interdisciplinary research
