






Index of Farmer Sentiment





Annual Change in Retail Food Prices











Is Consumer Demand Changing?

Change in Wholesale Pork Supply and Demand








Aggregate Consumer Food Spending



Consumer Spending – Debit and Credit Cards


Percent Change in All Consumer Spending*






(a) Retail Price Impact









Stock Prices of Meat Packing Firms










Keep an eye out ...
