**Hours**

- On days that the ADDL is “Open 9-3”, the ADDL front desk will be staffed to answer calls and take in samples as usual. Same day testing will occur as usual, and our laboratory technicians will continue to report and move testing forward each day.
- The Purdue West Lafayette campus will shut down for Winter Recess December 22, 2022 and reopen January 3, 2023.
- Potential delays in testing:
  - o Sequencing turnaround times may be delayed by 1-2 business days.
  - o Trich and Salmonella PCR testing – samples received on Nov. 23, Dec 22, and Dec. 29 will not be completed until the following Monday/Tuesday when the lab is open.
  - o VN samples will not be set the week of Nov. 21 or Dec. 26. Please call if needing VN.
  - o EIA AGID will NOT be started on Nov. 23; Dec. 22, 29; Jan 6, 20.
  - o BVD ACE testing will be completed on Nov. 23, Dec. 22, and Dec. 29 for those weeks.
  - o Lepto MAT & Drag Swabs will not be tested the week of December 26.
  - o Please contact the ADDL with any questions regarding turnaround times.

**Shipping Reminders**

- Any time sensitive shipments should be sent next day air during the holidays.
  - o Always check with the courier service to ensure delivery times and schedules.
- To ensure delivery and avoid potential delays, it is recommended to avoid sending samples via the US Postal Service between December 8<sup>th</sup> and January 3<sup>rd</sup>.
