Hours

- On days that the ADDL is “Open 9-3”, the ADDL front desk will be staffed to answer calls and take in samples as usual. Same day testing will occur as usual, and our laboratory technicians will continue to report and move testing forward each day.
- The Purdue West Lafayette campus will shut down for Winter Recess December 22, 2023 and reopen January 2, 2024.
- Potential delays in testing:
 - o Sequencing turnaround times may be delayed by 1-2 business days.
 - o Trich and Salmonella PCR testing – samples received on Nov. 22, Dec 22, and Dec. 29 will not be completed until the following business day when the lab is open.
 - o EIA AGID will NOT be started on Nov. 22; Dec. 21, 22, 29; Jan 5, 12, 19.
 - o BVD ACE testing will ONLY be completed on Nov. 22, Dec. 21, and Dec. 29 for those weeks.
 - o Drag Swabs will not be tested the week of December 25.
 - o Lepto MAT samples received after noon on Dec. 22 will not be tested until Friday, Dec. 29.
 - o Please contact the ADDL with any questions regarding turnaround times.

Shipping Reminders

- Any time sensitive shipments should be sent next day air during the holidays.
 - o Always check with the courier service to ensure delivery times and schedules.
- To ensure delivery and avoid potential delays, it is recommended to avoid sending samples via the US Postal Service between December 7th and January 2nd.
