DR. AMELIA WOOLUMS

DVM, PhD, DACVM
Mississippi State University

Dr. Amelia Woolums is the Mikell and Mary Cheek Hall Davis Endowed Professor of Beef Cattle Health and Reproduction in the Department of Pathobiology and Population Medicine at Mississippi State University. Dr. Woolums received her DVM in 1988 from Purdue University. She then completed an internship at Kansas State University, a residency at the University of Saskatchewan, and a PhD in Comparative Pathology at UC Davis, where she studied cell-mediated immune responses of cattle to BRSV vaccination. Dr. Woolums is a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine, and the American College of Veterinary Microbiologists. At the Mississippi State University, Dr. Woolums works in the farm animal teaching hospital; she also gives lectures to veterinary students, and she conducts research on BRD prevention, antimicrobial resistance in BRD, and vaccination and immunity in cattle and calves.
